- 2010-321 D: to promote participatory and peaceful elections in Côte d'Ivoire by reinforcing mechanisms for mitigating election-related conflict; and advocating for more women candidates for upcoming legislative elections, \$550,000.
- 2011-289 V: to promote national reconciliation and political reform in Côte d'Ivoire by fostering dialogue on peaceful political participation and national reconciliation; and promoting consensus among key Ivoirian political and civic actors on priority areas for political and electoral reforms, \$450,000.
- 2012-283 BB: to promote dialogue and inclusive political processes in Côte d'Ivoire by fostering dialogue among Ivoirian political parties at the local level in targeted communities on issues of concern to the local population; and enhancing the ability of women in targeted communities to contest for seats in the 2012 local elections, \$450,000.

- 2015-0133 C: to assist Ivoirian civic groups to engage citizens in mitigating the risk of election-related violence through a coordinated multimedia campaign, and support an Ivoirian coalition in raising awareness of the principles in the political party code of conduct for elections, \$250,000.
