Are there party policies or procedures focused on female party members?

Are there policies to prevent harassment or violence against female candidates within the party?

ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS FOR GOVERNMENT BODIES, INCLUDING ELECTIONS MANAGEMENT BODIES

How does the organization work to prevent harassment or violence against women within the electoral process?

ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS FOR ELECTED BODIES, INCLUDING LOCAL COUNCILS AND PARLIAMENTS

What percentage of elected officials serving are women?

Does this organization focus on issues that disproportionately impact women?

Is there a women's caucus or other structures?
