## INTERNATIONAL DELEGATION TO THE REPUBLIC OF KENYA HOLDS PRESS CONFERENCE

An international delegation to the Republic of Kenya sponsored by the Washington, D.C.-based National Democratic Institute for International Affairs (NDI) will be holding a press conference on Thursday, February 6 at 4:00 p.m. in the Hilton Hotel's Salt Lick room.

The five member international delegation, led by NDI President J. Brian Atwood, will discuss its assessment of preparations for multiparty elections in Kenya. The delegation's mission takes place at an important phase of Kenya's transition to multiparty democracy. The delegation seeks to enhance confidence in the future electoral process by providing assurances that the international community stands ready to assist in this process.

The delegation also includes: Jean Jolin, Deputy Director General of Elections of Québec; Billie A. Miller, a member of Parliament in opposition in Barbados; Reverend Foston D. Sakala, Chairman of the Zambian Election Monitoring Coordinating Committee; and Lionel C. Johnson, NDI Senior Program Officer.
