#### **METHODOLOGY**



#### DATA COLLECTION

25 March – 18 April, 2017

#### **METHOD**

- Quantitative face to face survey within households
- Computer Assisted Personal Interviewing (CAPI method)

#### POPULATION

Population of Bosnia and Herzegovina aged 18+

#### SAMPLE FRAME

Polling station territories database (CEC)

#### SAMPLE SIZE

- N=2000 (1000 in FBiH, 1000 in RS)
- Data are weighted where necessary (by region, age, gender and education) in order to reflect the true population allocation according to the 2013 census

#### SAMPLING ERROR

- +/- 2.2% on full sample
- +/- 3.1% at entity level

#### SAMPLE TYPE

Stratified sample

#### STRATIFICATION

 Within each entity the sample was stratified by region and settlement type

#### STEPS OF RANDOM SELECTION


- Step 1: Random selection of polling stations
- Step 2: Random selection of households (random route technique)
- Step 3: Random selection of respondents within HH (Kisch scheme)

## **OVERVIEW**



#### Citizens see BiH heading in the wrong direction; RS respondents are a bit less pessimistic about their entity than those in FBiH.





#### Pessimism in both entities is tied to the lack of economic and political progress in unemployment and corruption.






What would you name as the two biggest problems that FBiH is facing today?

## Many think interethnic relations have deteriorated in the past year.






Compared to a year ago, do you think that interethnic relations in BiH are better, worse or about the same? Base: Total N=2000



#### Citizens view ethnic reconciliation as essential for the future of BiH.






In your opinion, how important is the reconciliation process for the future of BiH? Base: Total N=2000






In your opinion, how important is the reconciliation process for the future of BiH? Base: Total N=2000

## People are convinced that politicians use ethnic tension for political gain rather than try to reduce it.



## There are no significant differences among age groups on politicians' motives regarding inter-ethnic relations.



## There are no significant differences between entities on politicians' motives regarding inter-ethnic relations.



## About one-half of BiH citizens are worried that ethnic tension might lead to armed conflict.






How worried are you that ethnic tension in BiH might lead to armed conflict?

## A similar percentage thinks that ethnic tensions might lead to the dissolution of the state.






And how likely do you think it is that the ongoing ethnic tension might lead to the dissolution of the state? Base: Total N=2000

## There is significant concern about radical extremism in BiH, especially among Serbs.






How concerned are you about the threat of radical extremism in BiH? Base: Total N=2000


#### Almost six-in-10 express concern about foreign interference in the political affairs of BiH.






## Support for EU membership remains strong among Bosniaks and Croats; Serbs are evenly split.








Do you personally support or oppose BiH accession to EU?

## Many doubt that BiH will gain EU candidate status within the next 5 years.






Regardless of how you just answered, do you expect BiH to gain EU candidate status within the next 5 years?



## A majority of respondents point to public sector hiring as the most corrupt process.






Which of the following processes is most corrupt?

#### Citizens favorably view a variety of measures to reduce corruption, including economic progress and EU influence.





#### General consensus on the drivers of corruption in BiH.



#### Citizens favorably rate a number of measures to fight corruption directed at privatization and political influence.



#### Confiscation of illegally obtained assets is considered the most important measure in reducing corruption.






Of the measures we have just discussed, please tell me which 2 OR 3 you think are the MOST important?

#### Prosecutors, the judiciary, and the international community have the most credibility on corruption measures.






And what would be the most credible group to implement and enforce such an anti-corruption package?

# A majority of citizens feels the international community must be part of any anti-corruption initiative in BiH, but fewer Serbs agree.







# The Federation government is seen as failing to implement policies that improve the lives of citizens.





## Citizens clearly want the FBiH government to focus on corruption and socioeconomic reforms.






What should be the priority of the FBiH Government at this time?

Which of the following statements best describes your personal view about the territorial arrangement of the Federation BiH?



## Citizens perceive the RS administration as performing poorly.



## RS residents want action on corruption and socioeconomic reform, not ethnic protection.







### Statewide, about half of respondents would certainly vote if elections were held now.










Which of the following statements comes closest to your view of elections in Bosnia and Herzegovina?

# Election administration and both domestic and international observers help ensure election integrity; political parties do not.



### One-third of BiH citizens are familiar with domestic election monitoring coalition *Pod Lupom*.





After a description, half of respondents think *Pod* Lupom can contribute to the integrity of the electoral process.







Now that you know more about "Pod Lupom", how effective do you think such a coalition can be in contributing to public knowledge of the electoral process and preventing violations of the electoral rules?










