# Why We Conduct Polls?

- Foster the development of more responsive policies and governance;
- Help stakeholders diagnose and address issues of public concern;

- leaders from across the political spectrum have reported that the polls are important to their work and encourage continued polling;

- Inclusive process: the polling instrument was developed in consultation with parties, government, and civil society leaders;

# Information about the poll

- Fieldwork dates: March 20 – April 4
- 2194 completed interviews (46% response rate)
- A nationally representative sample (excluding occupied territories) including oversampled areas of the Capital, large Urban, small Urban, Rural and minority settlements
- large Urban stratum consists of the cities with 40K and more population: Batumi, Zugdidi, Rustavi, Poti, Gori, Kutaisi
- Small Urban stratum consists of the rest of the cities/dabas holding urban status
- Minority stratum consists of population of those settlements, where ethnic minorities (mostly Armenians and Azeri) make at least 40% of the voters in given settlement. Settlements within this stratum are dispersed through Kvemo Kartli, Samtskhe-Javakheti and kakheti regions.
- The average margin of error is +/- 2,2%

# Methodology

## Sample design



NDI and CRRC use a complex survey design:

- ✓ **Stratification** – dividing population in relatively homogenous sub-groups
  - ✓ **Clustering** – randomly selecting small geographic areas for each sub-group (stratum)
- 
- Households are selected via random route sampling
  - Respondents are selected using a Kish table
  - Randomly selected households and individuals are not substituted
  - All interviews were conducted face-to-face, in Georgian, Armenian and Azeri.

# How NDI Survey is Conducted

1

At the first stage, CRRC randomly selects voting precincts in Georgia. Interviewers are sent there with given starting point, directions for walking, step size, number of contacts.

Interviewer randomly selects households according to the given step size, e.g. every 3rd, 5th, 8th...

3

The respondent is selected randomly, with special method - so called Kish grid. Selected respondent cannot be replaced.



Interviewer conducts an interview with the selected household member. Interviewer uses tablet computer and a special software.

Interviewer submits the results via the internet to the special server.






# In which direction is Georgia going? (q1)










## How would you rate the performance of the current government? (q2a)








**After the parliamentary elections of October 2016 has the level of crime in Georgia ...? (q4)**






## Which country would offer Georgia best security? (q28)




## Which country poses biggest threat to Georgia? (q29)




## What is the top threat to Georgia's national security? (q30)


























## If approve, why do you approve it? (q12) - of the 75% who approve Georgian government's stated goal to join the EU






# Have you heard about the visa liberalization for Georgian citizens traveling to most of EU member countries? (q16)




# Do you feel you have enough information about the procedures/rules of Visa free travel? (q17) - of those who have heard about visa liberalization











## Do you approve or disapprove of Georgian government's stated goal to join the NATO? (q20)












## How would you rate the performance of Tbilisi Sakrebulo? (q5) Asked in Tbilisi









# If parliamentary elections were held tomorrow, would you vote? (q7)




# If parliamentary elections were tomorrow which party would you vote for? (q8) Whole sample






Russia spreads lies/false information in Georgia when promoting its image and interests



European Union spreads lies/false information in Georgia when promoting its image and interests




USA spreads lies/false information in Georgia when promoting its image and interests





## What are main sources of information for receiving news about Georgian politics and current events? (q49, q50)




## Which TV channel do you trust the most for accurate information on politics and current events? (q53)




# Do you think that coverage of news about Georgian politics and current affairs on Public Broadcaster (Channel One) ...? (q48)

Only 4% of population says they trust GPB for accurate information on politics and current events




# Do you watch coverage of news and current affairs on non-Georgian TV channels? (q51)




## Which non-Georgian TV channels do you watch? (q52) - of the 18% who said they watch non-Georgian TV Channels

















## Speaking about a monetary spending/income last month, to which of the following groups does your household belong? (q57, q62)


