# METHODOLOGY

<b>Realization:</b>	<b>Field research conducted in the period from 22 - 28.09.2017.</b>
<b>Sample frame:</b>	<b>Population of Serbia 18+</b>
<b>Sample size:</b>	<b>1050 respondents</b>
<b>Type of sample:</b>	<b>Three-stage random representative stratified sample</b> <b>Unit of the first stage: Territory of polling place</b> <b>Unit of the second stage: Households (SRSWoR – random walk)</b> <b>Unit of the third stage: Respondents within a household (Kish tables)</b>
<b>Type of research:</b>	<b>Field questionnaire – average duration 45 minutes</b>
<b>Place of survey:</b>	<b>67 municipalities from Serbia, 127 local communities, Central Serbia, suburban and Urban</b>
<b>Post-stratification:</b>	<b>By gender, age and region</b>
<b>Marginal error:</b>	<b>±1.45% for the occurrences with the expected incidence of 5%</b> <b>±2.86% for the occurrences with the expected incidence of 25%</b> <b>±3.31% for the occurrences with the expected incidence of 50%</b> <b>(marginal error)</b>

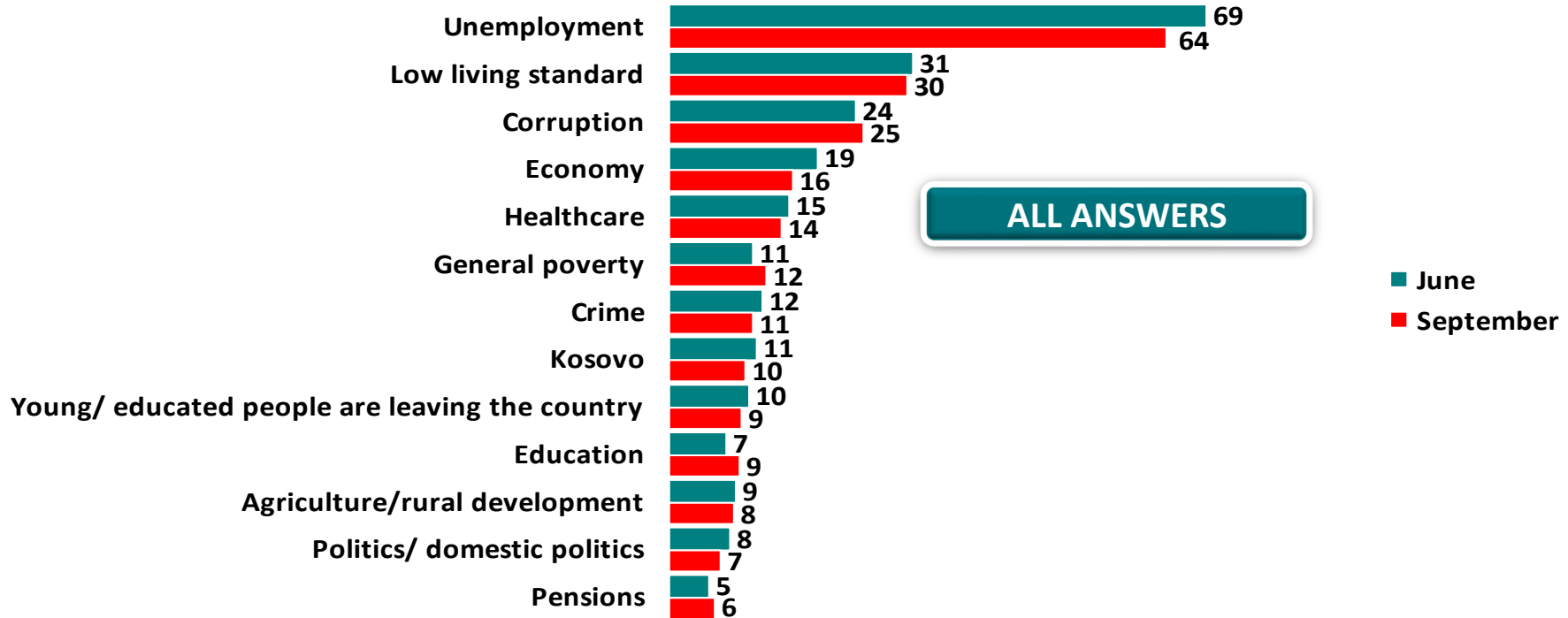

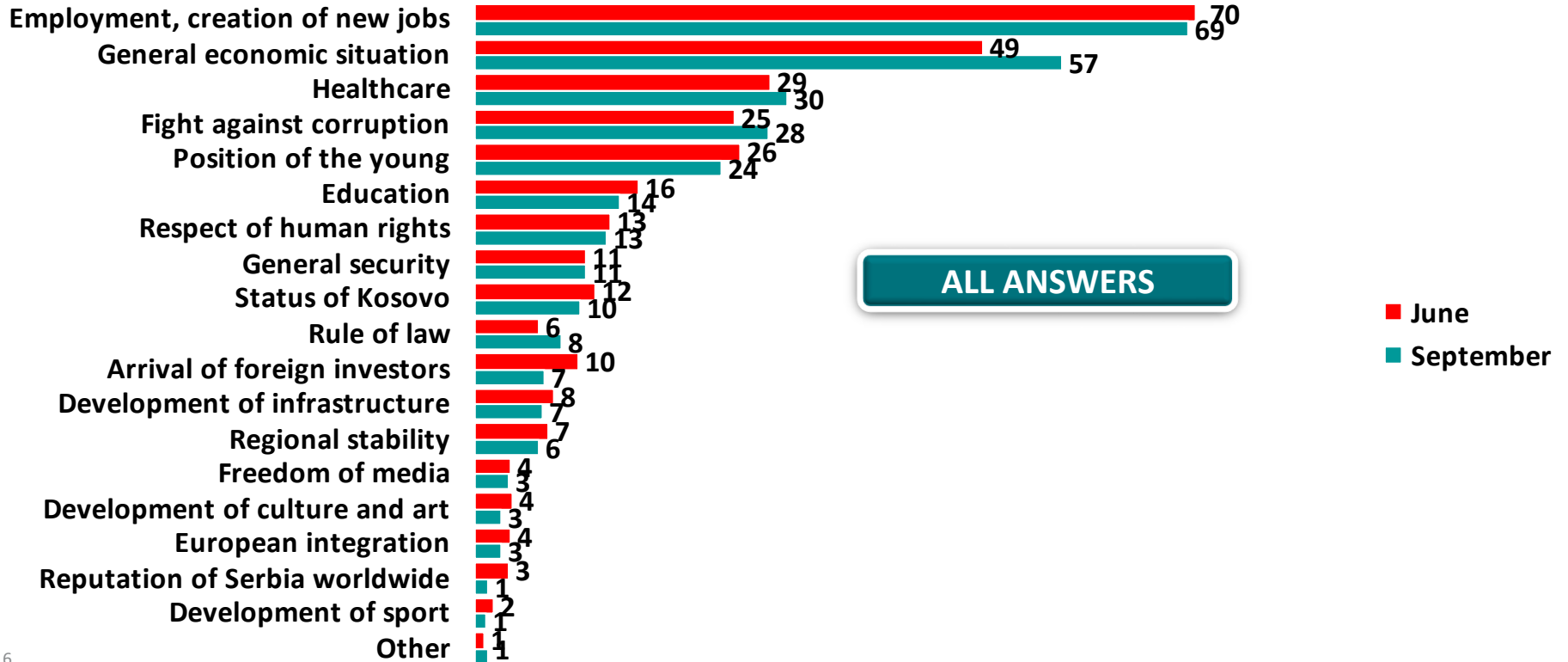
# Economic issues are most important to the citizens of Serbia

# Healthcare is also important for citizens of Serbia

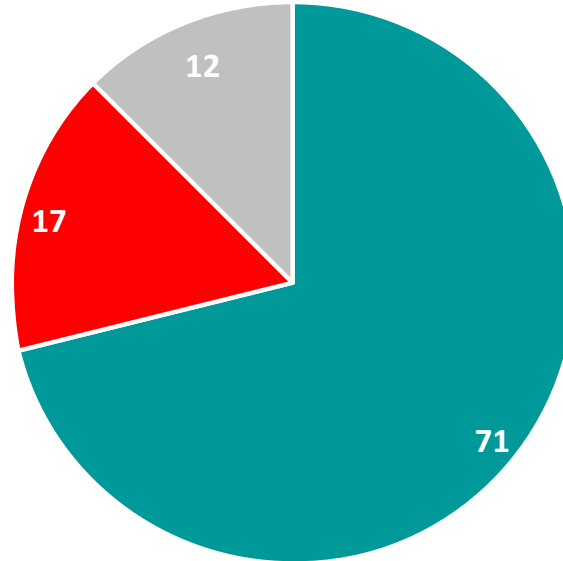
*In your opinion, which are the three areas in Serbia that are most important to you personally? Which one is in the first place, second place and the third place? – all answers*



# Seven out of 10 citizens think that city mayors/municipality presidents should be elected directly by citizens

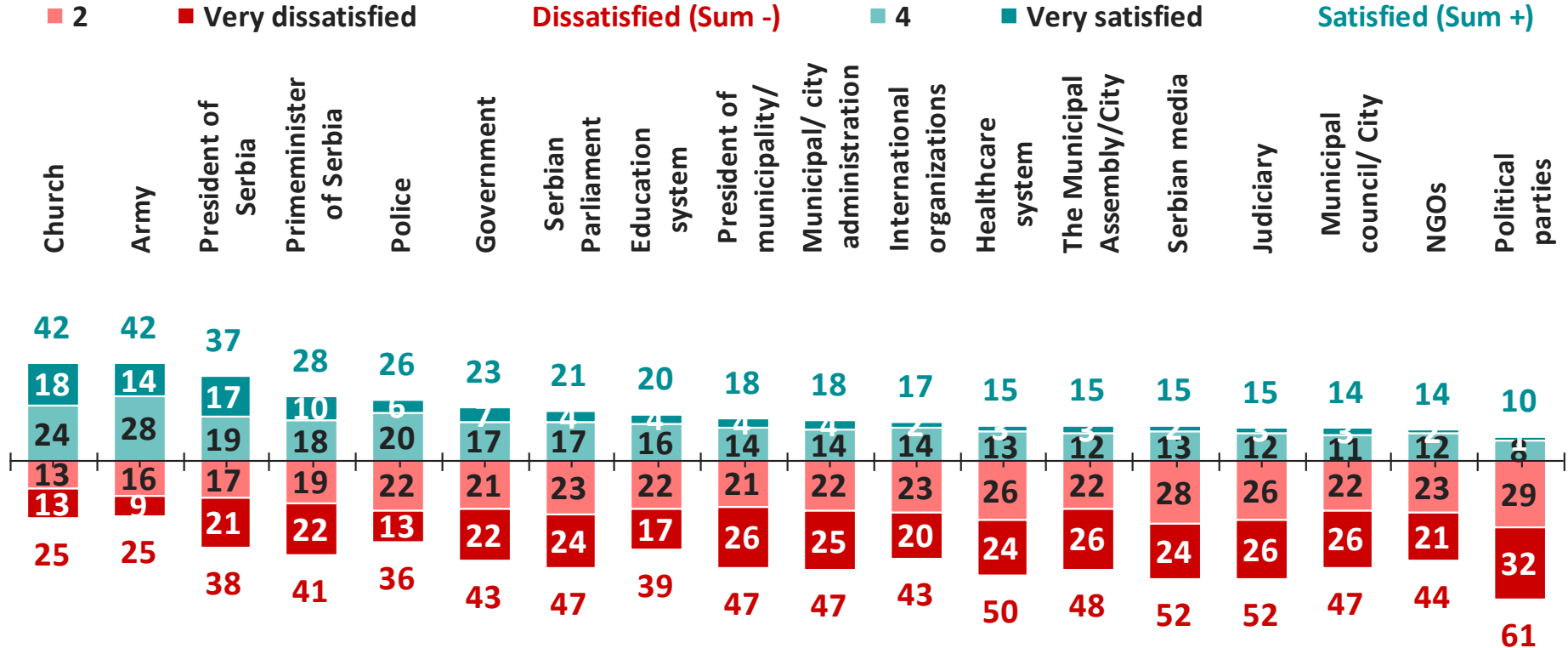
*In your opinion, city mayors and municipality presidents should be elected how?*

To what extent are you satisfied with the work of the following institutions?



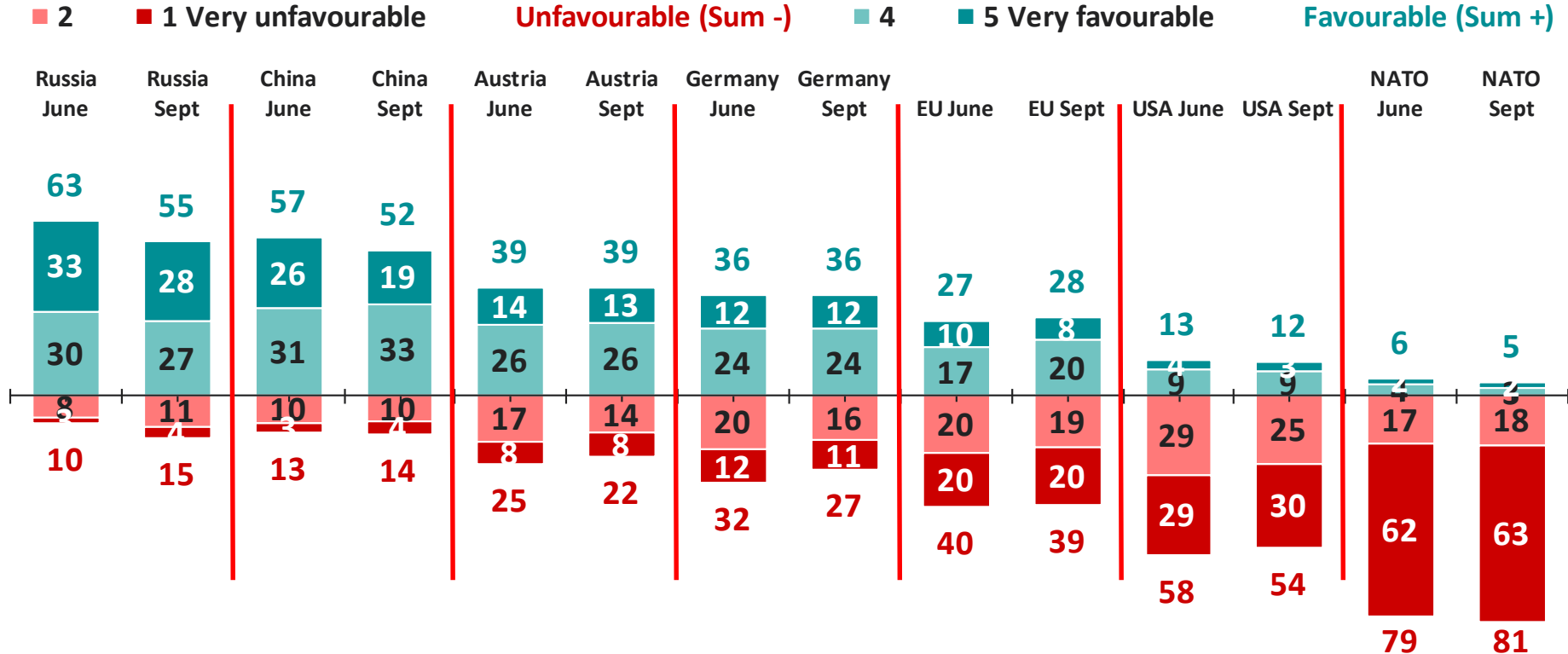

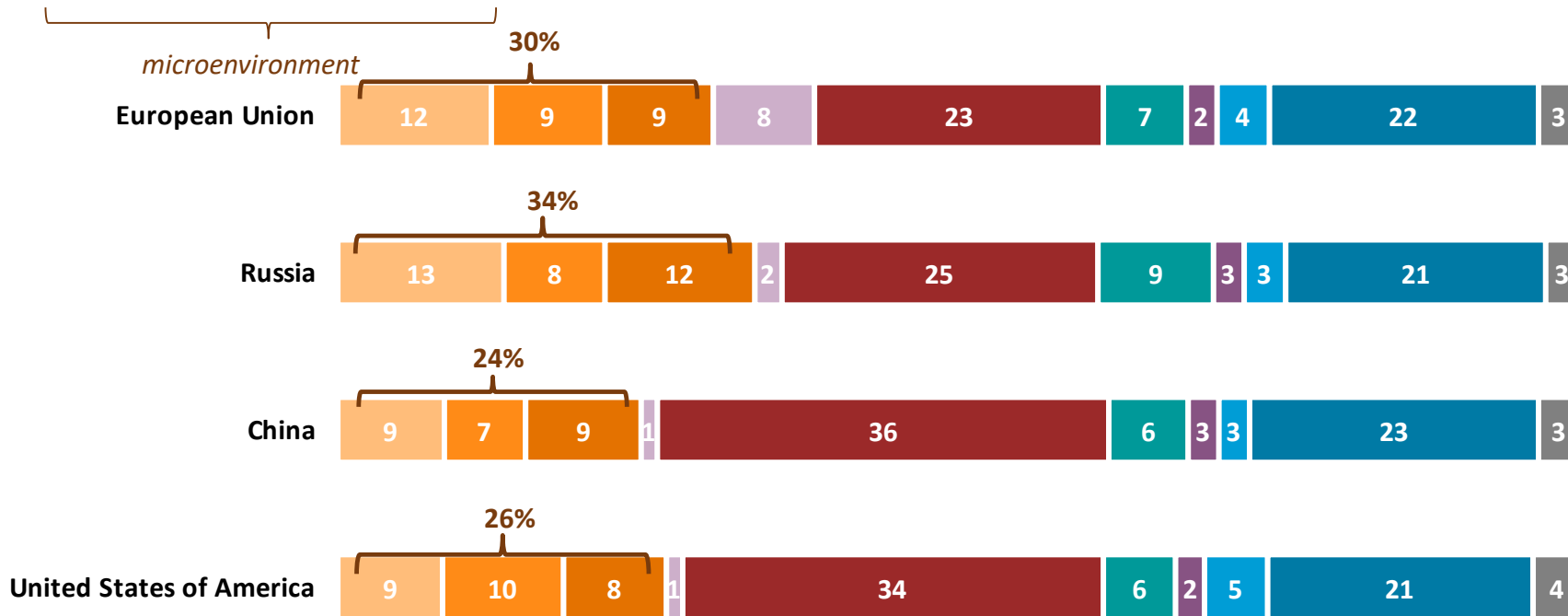

# 'Microenvironmental' factors exert influence over citizen opinion on the EU and Russia, and public figures with regard to China and the U.S.

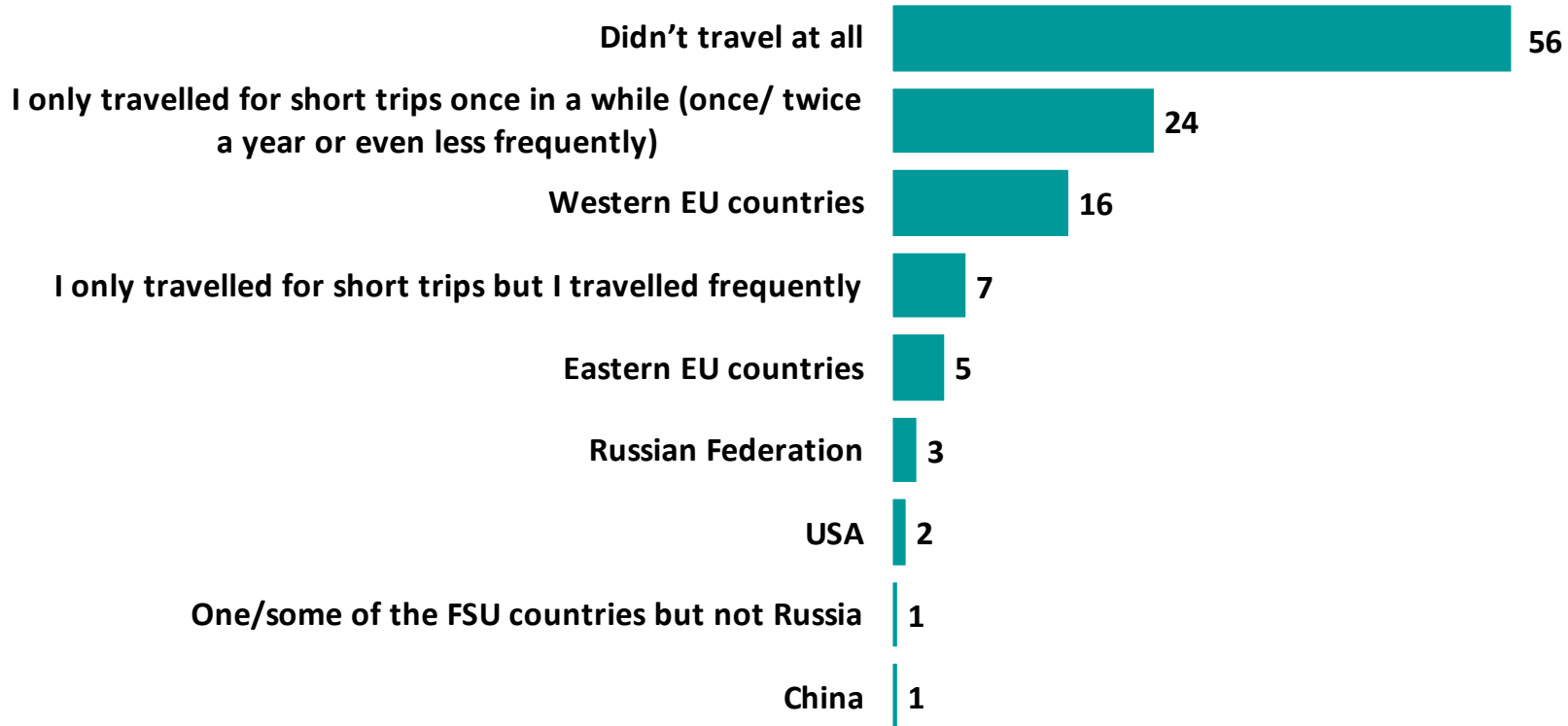
What influenced your opinion about the following states the most?

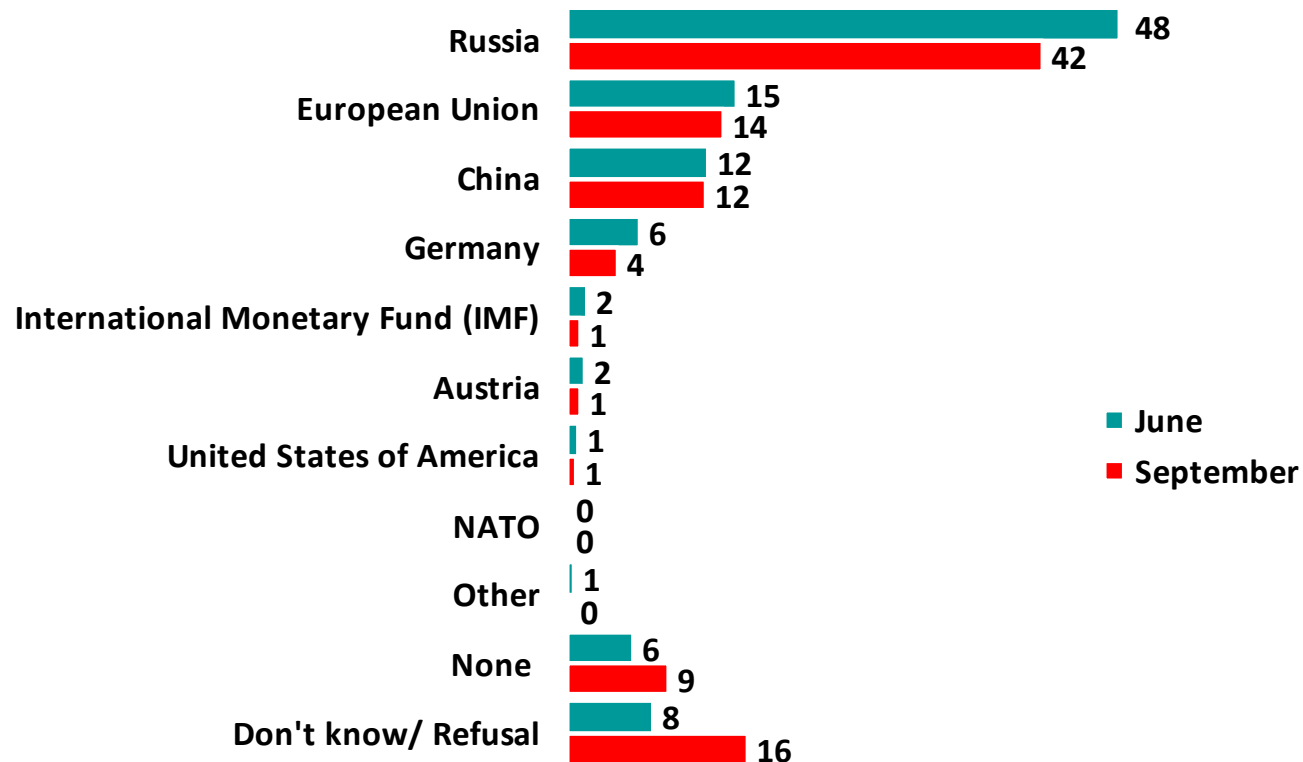
# One-quarter has recently travelled abroad

*Do you travel to any of these locations two or more times a year?*



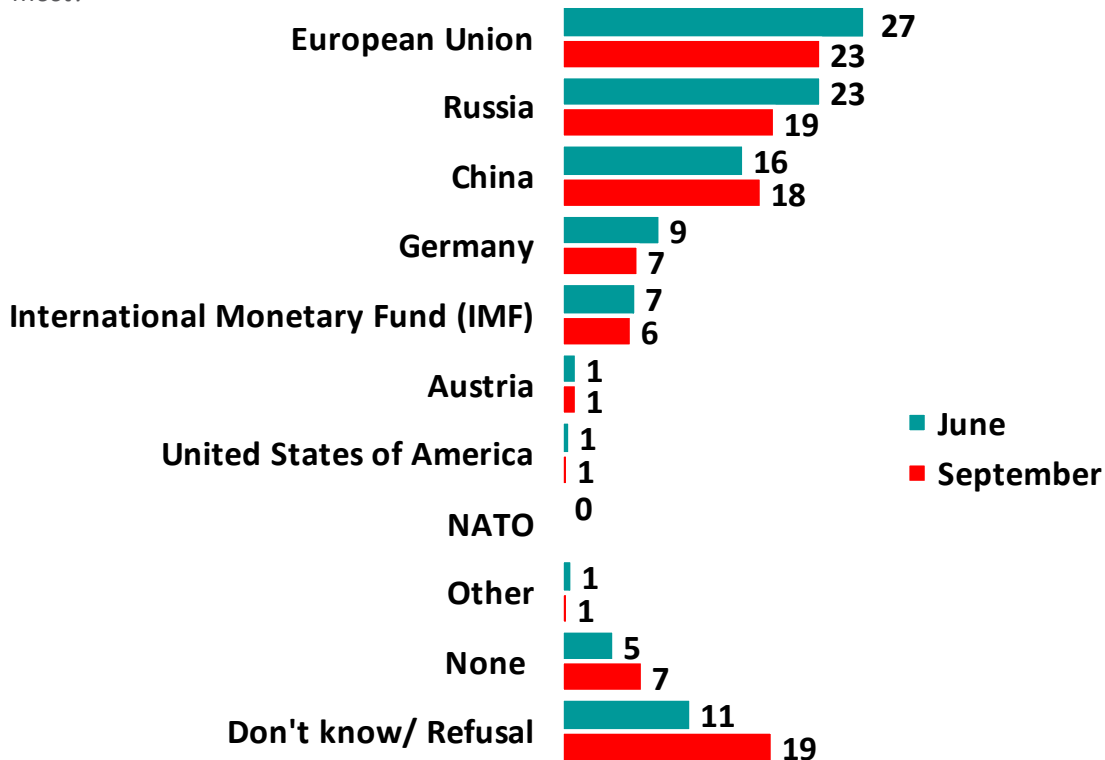
# Russia is perceived as Serbia's best partner

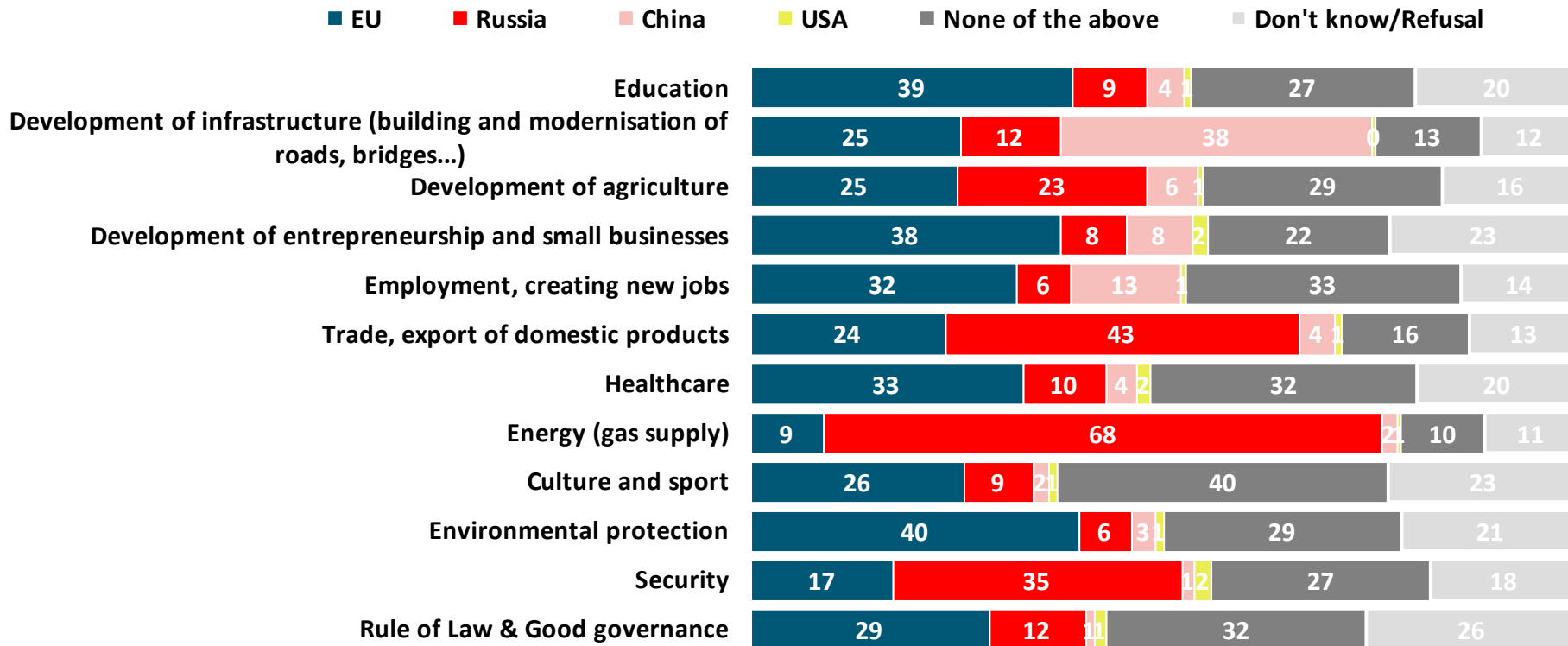

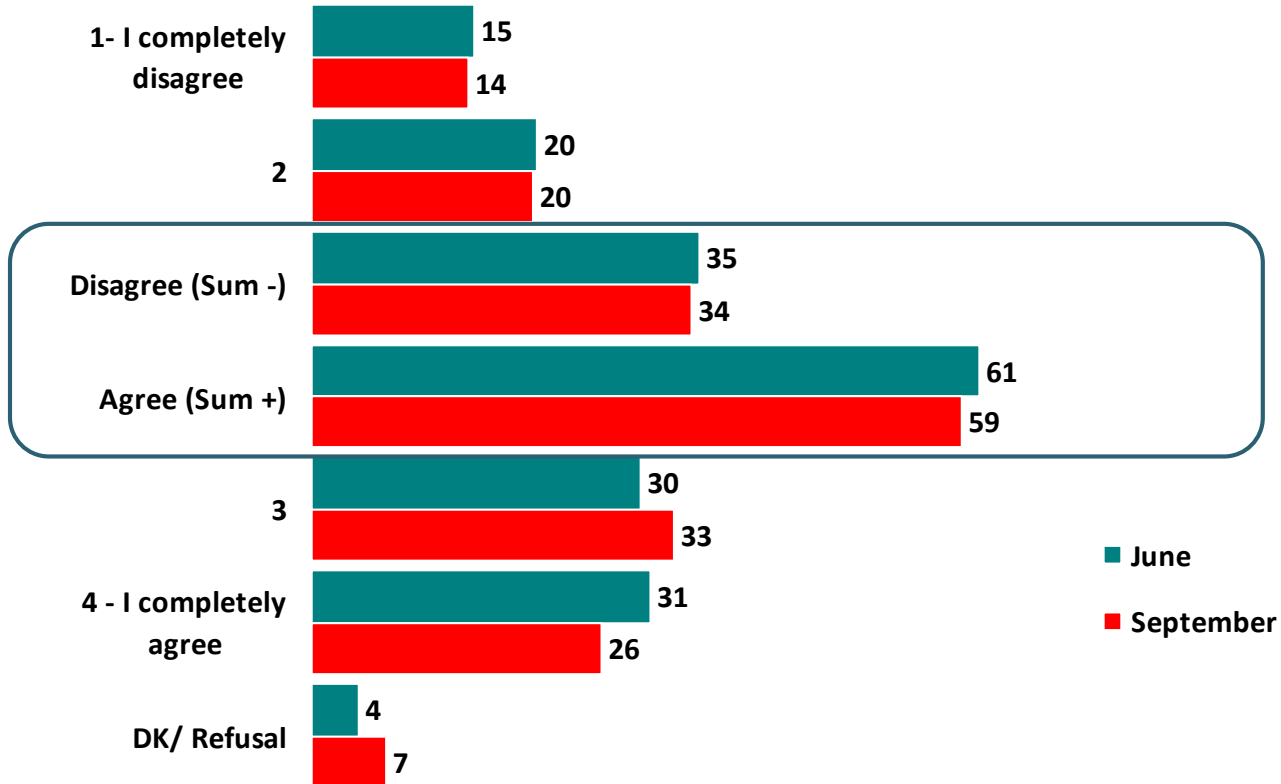

Who helps and invests in Serbia most of all to develop these areas?



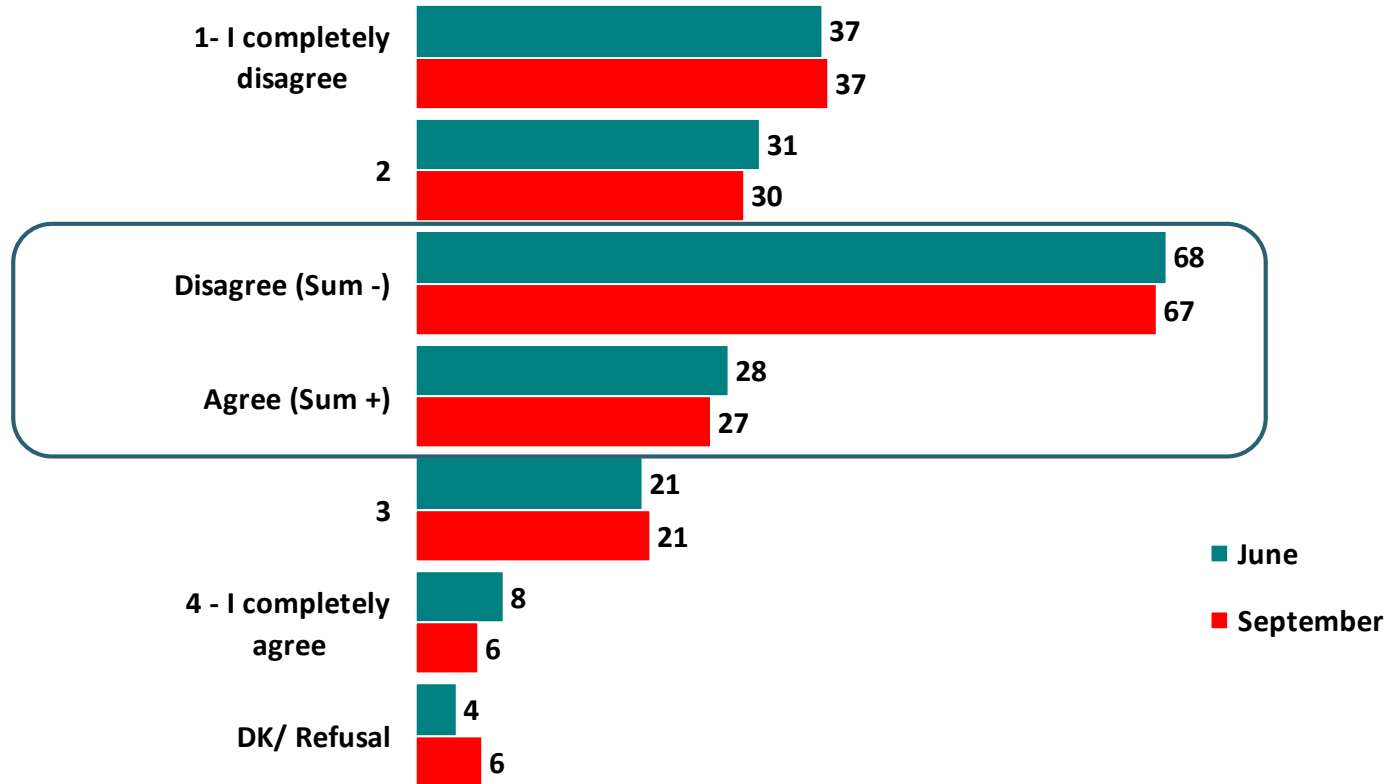
# Six-in-10 see Russia treating Serbia as an equal partner

To what extent do you agree with the following statement: Russia is treating Serbia as an equal partner?



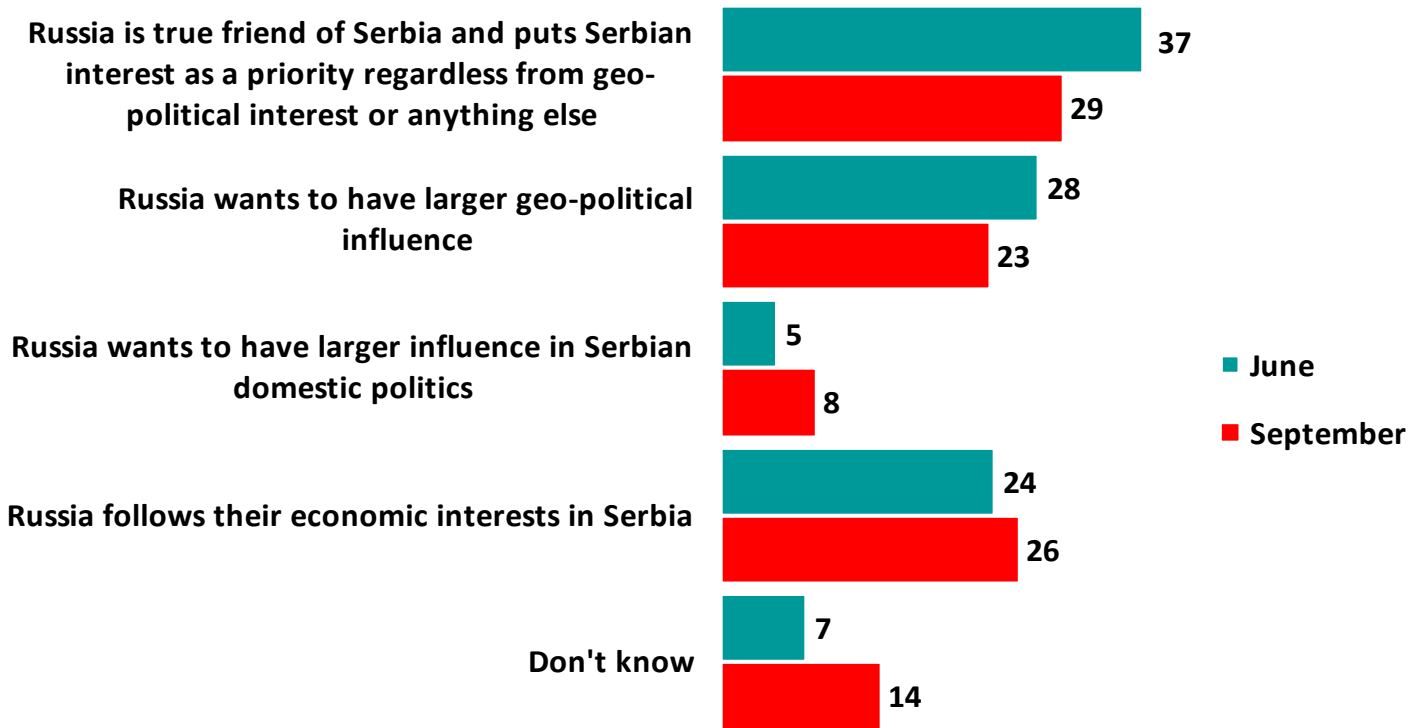
# Nearly 7-in-10 do not see the EU as treating Serbia as an equal partner.

To what extent do you agree with the following statement: The EU is treating Serbia as an equal partner?



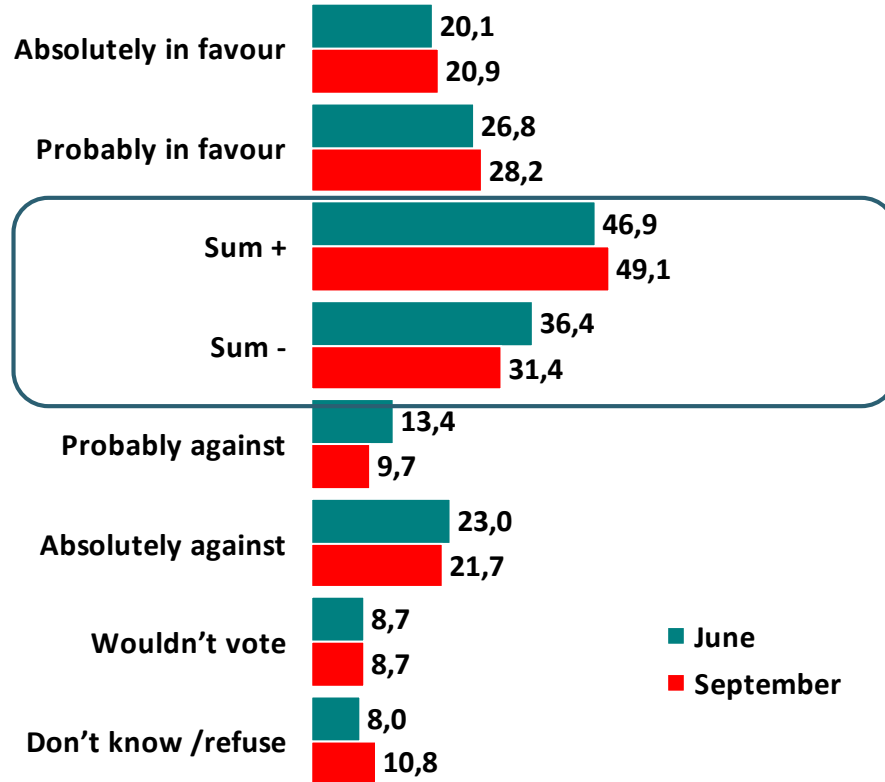
# Citizens see Russian self-interest and genuine support as the basis of its engagement with Serbia

*In your opinion, what is the most important reason why Russia is maintaining good relations with Serbia?*



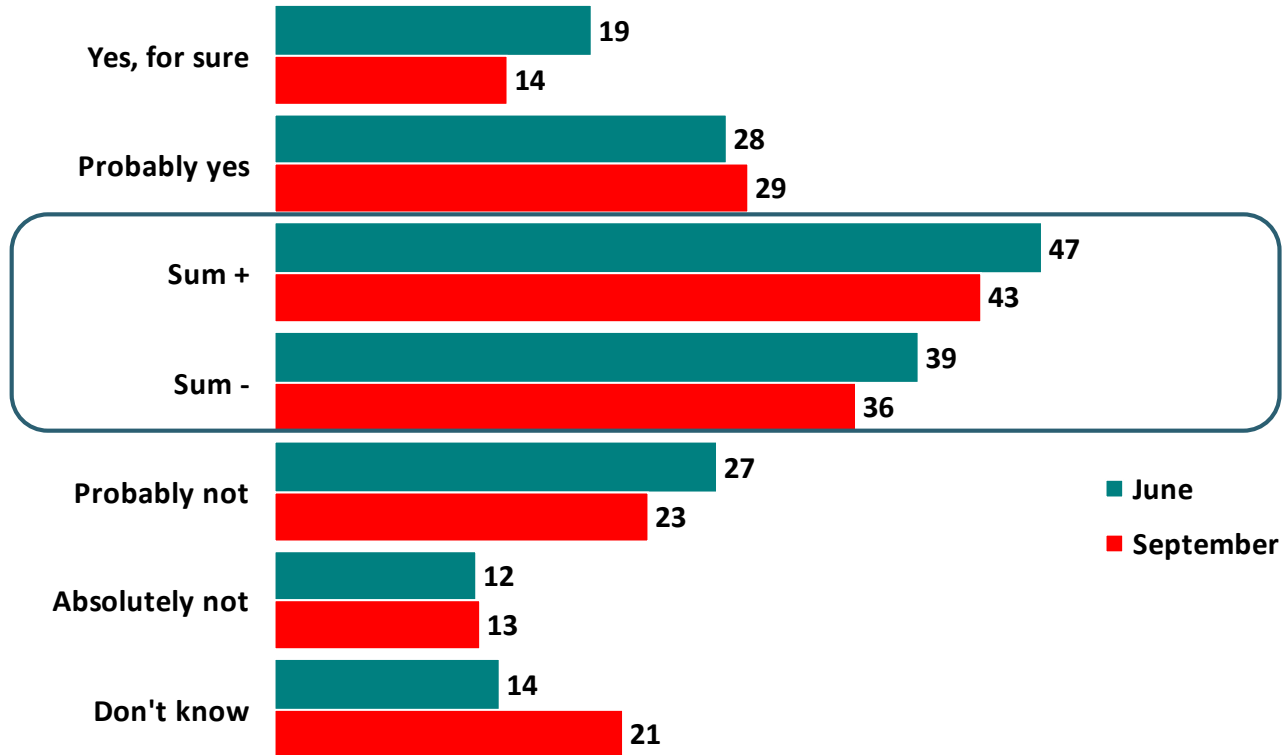
# EU membership support is just below 50 percent

# Citizens are lukewarm to jettisoning EU integration in favor of integration with Russia

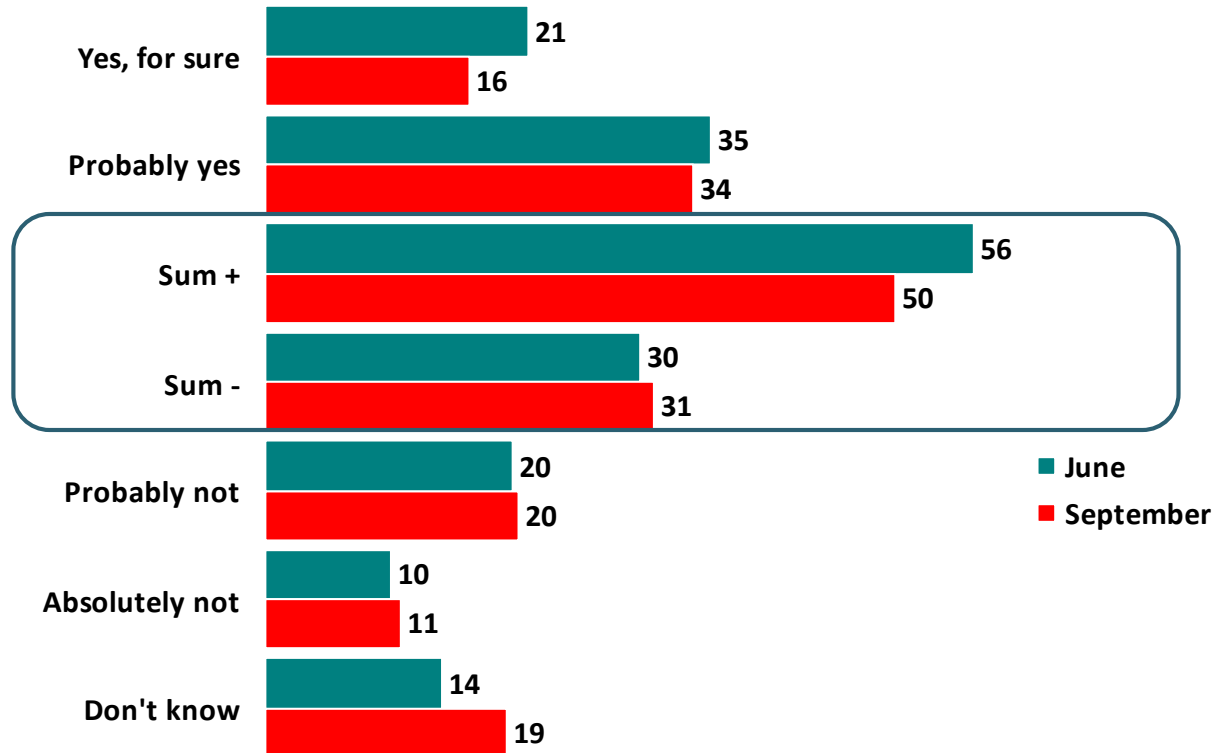
*Irrespective of your attitude towards the EU, do you think that Serbia would become a better place to live in if it gave up the EU integration and turned towards Russia?*





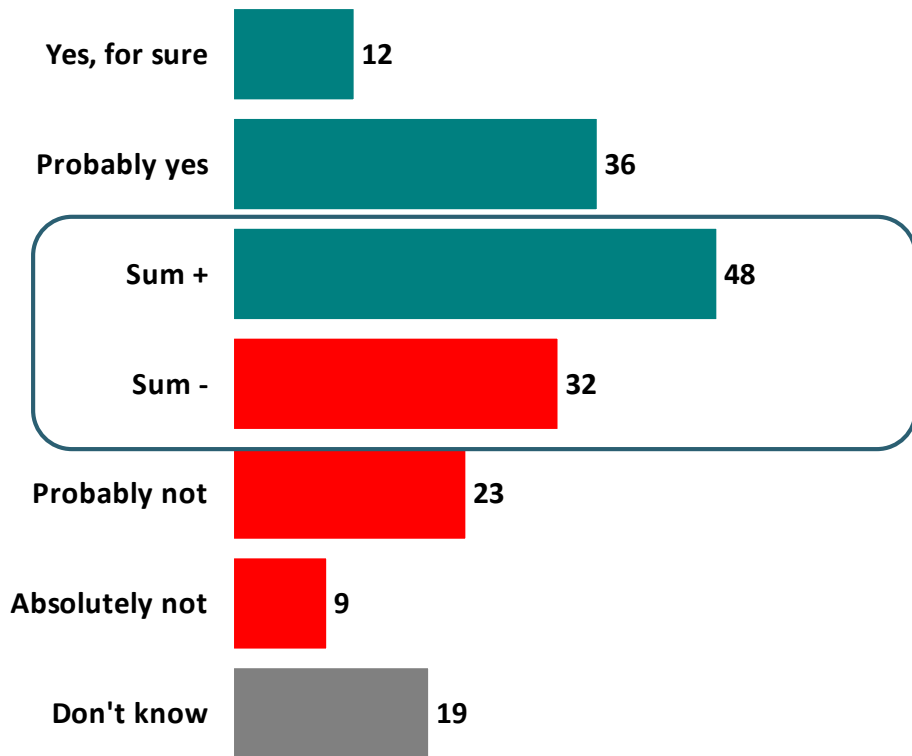
# A slight majority sees benefits to stronger economic links with Russia

Do you think that Serbia would be able to upgrade its economy if it chose Russia as its key partner?



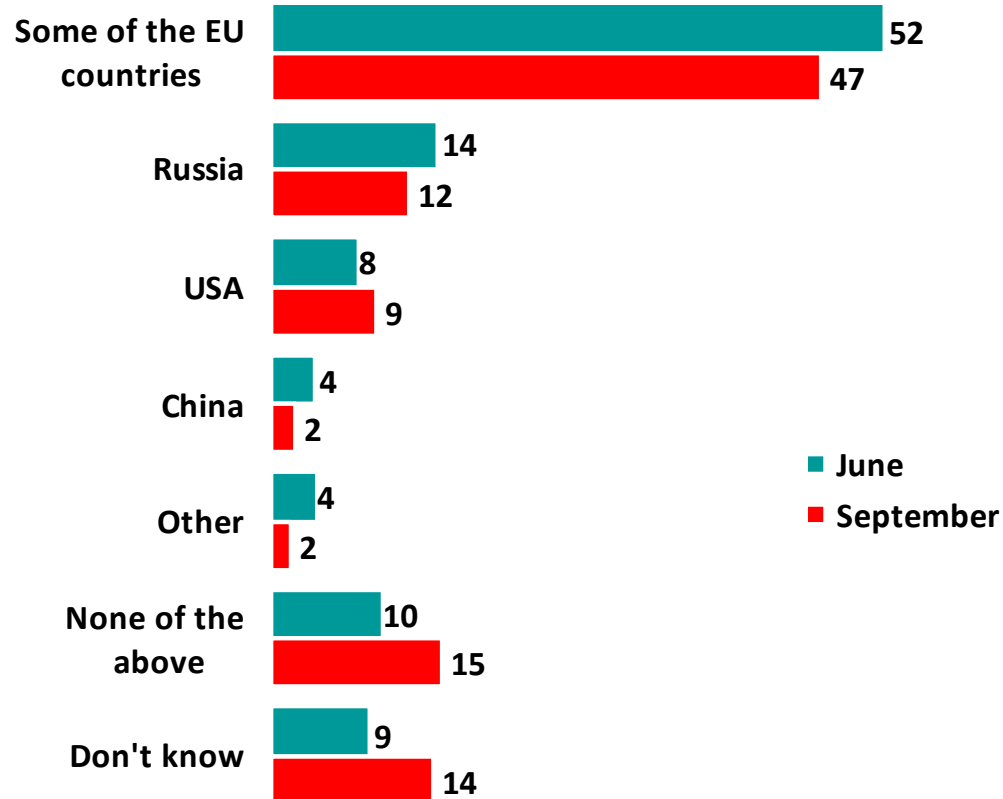
# A plurality sees economic benefits to stronger economic links with the EU

*And do you think that Serbia would be able to upgrade its economy if it chose EU as its key partner?*



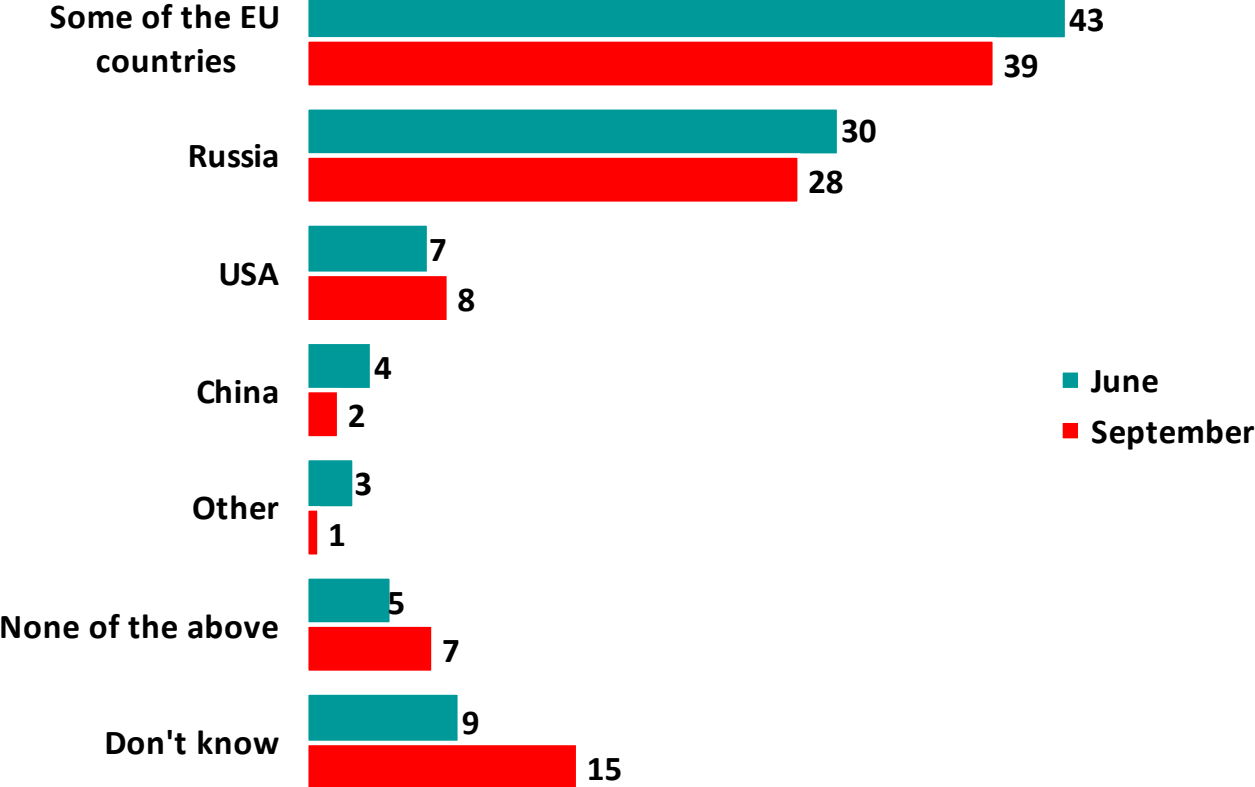
# The European Union is favored for professional and personal opportunities

If you or your family member needed a medical treatment or a surgery, which of these countries would you visit first?



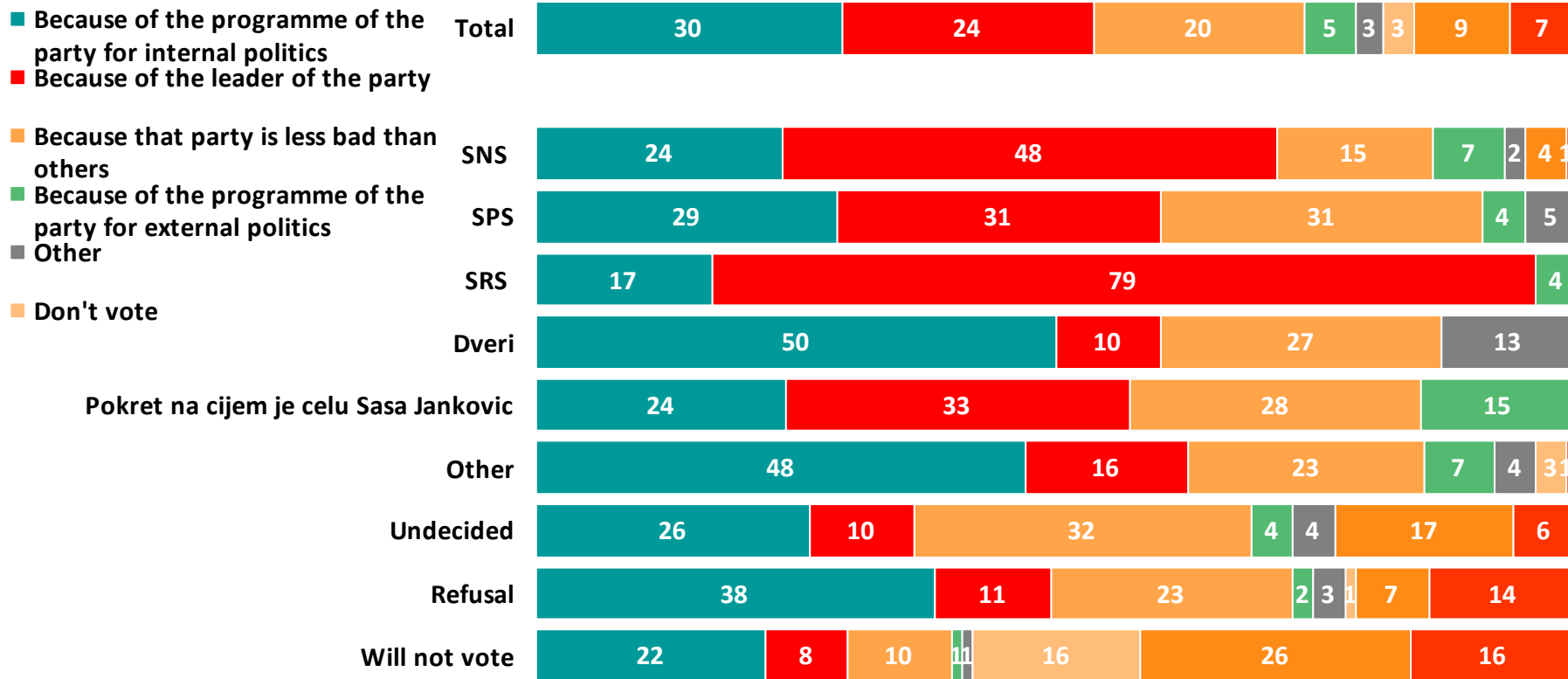

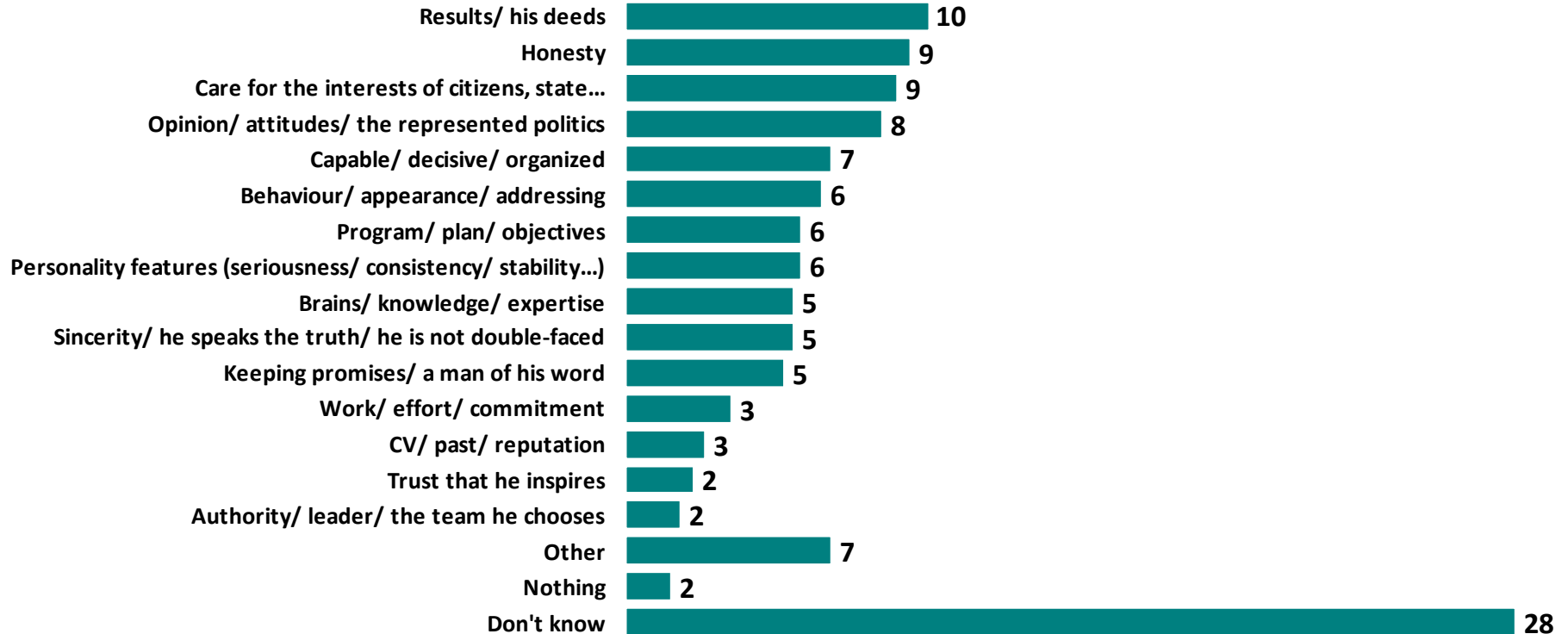
How do you decide to whom would you vote?

*What influences the most on your opinion about the politicians?*

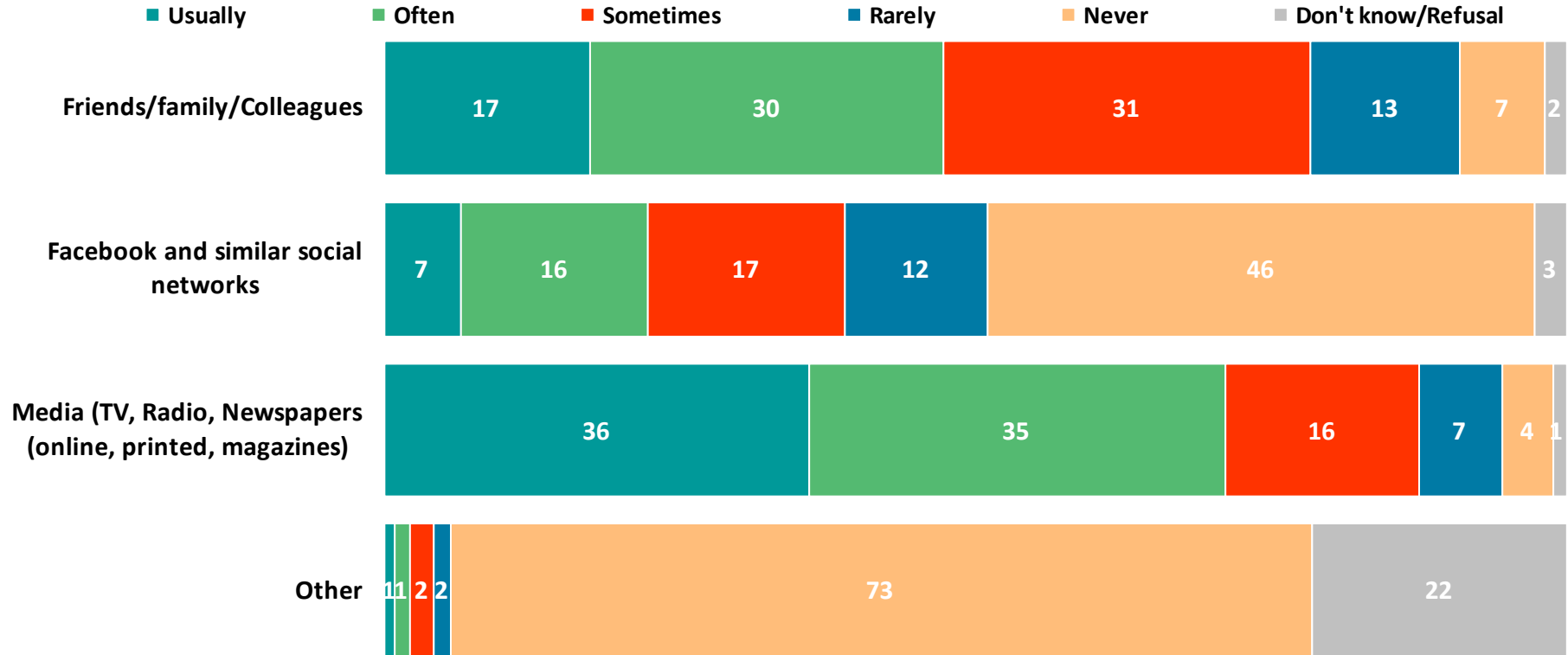

# Conventional media and immediate environment are the sources of citizen information on public affairs

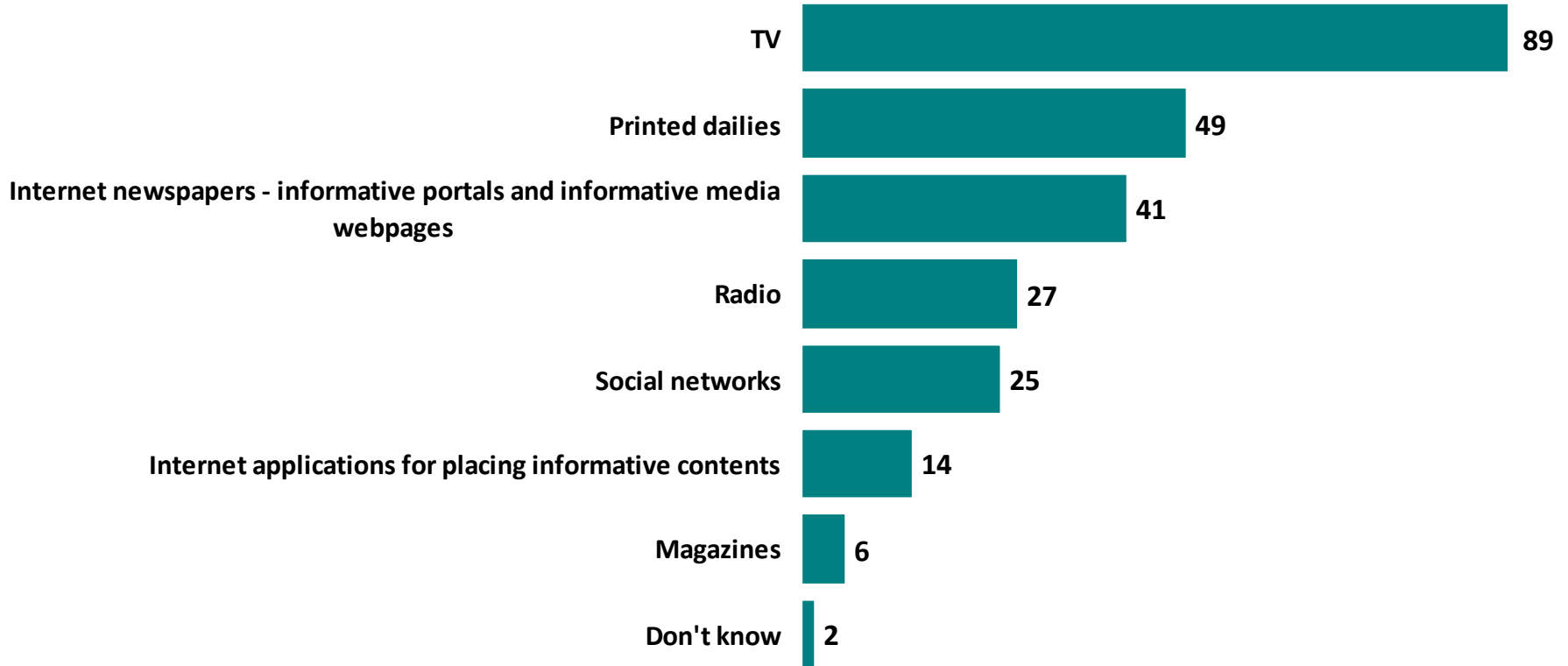
How do you usually get informed about social, political, economic and other similar local and global topics?



# TV is the most used source for information on public affairs

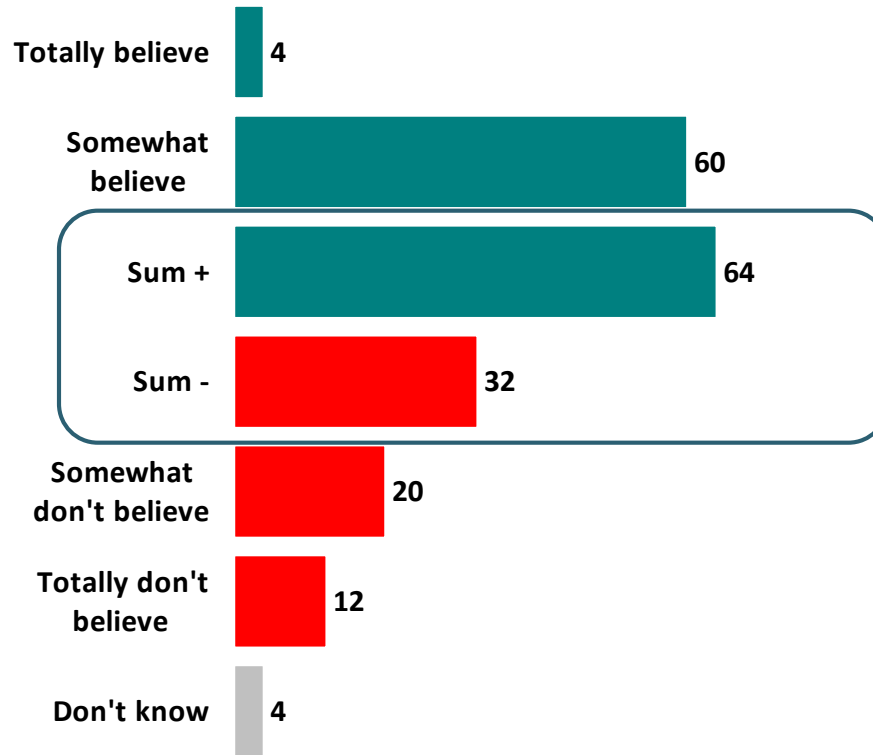
Through which medium do you usually get informed about social, political, economic and other similar local and global topics?

# A majority believes the information provided by media is credible

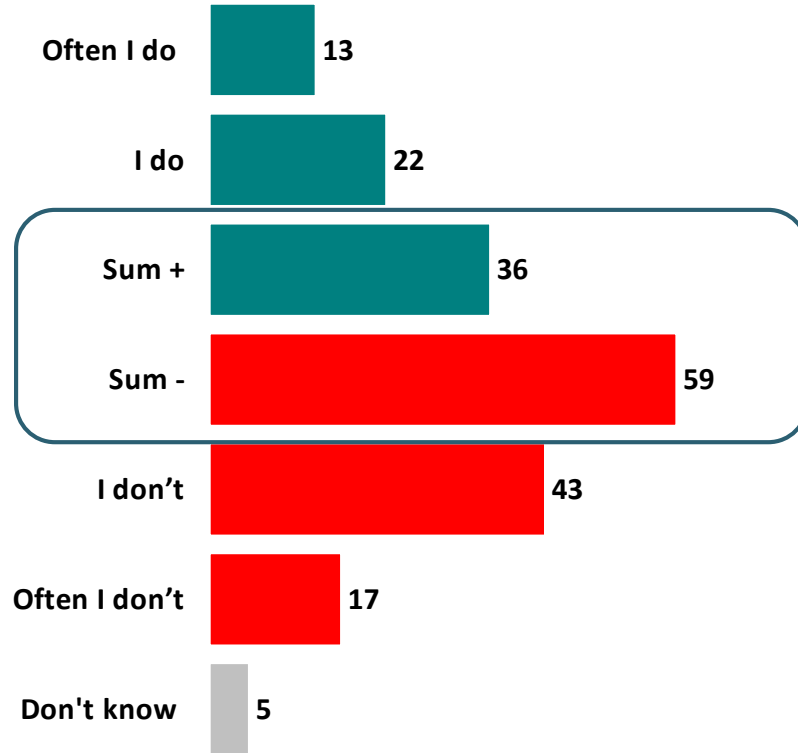
How much do you believe in the information gained through the media stated above?

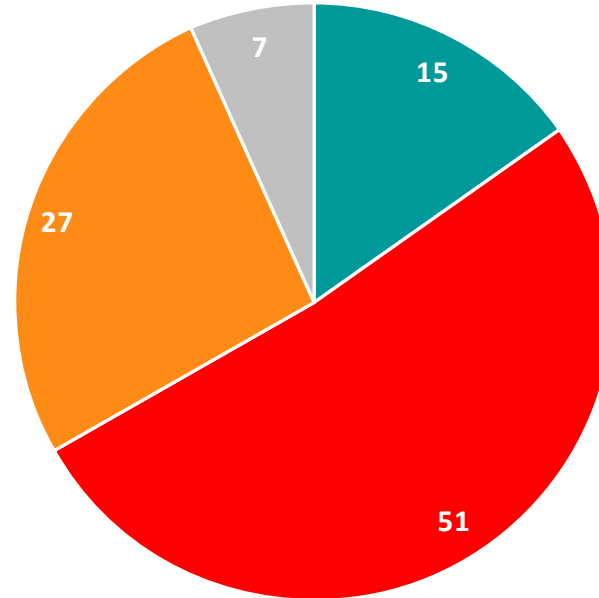


# A majority selectively goes beyond media headlines to read articles of interest.

When you read, listen or watch news in media, what you do?

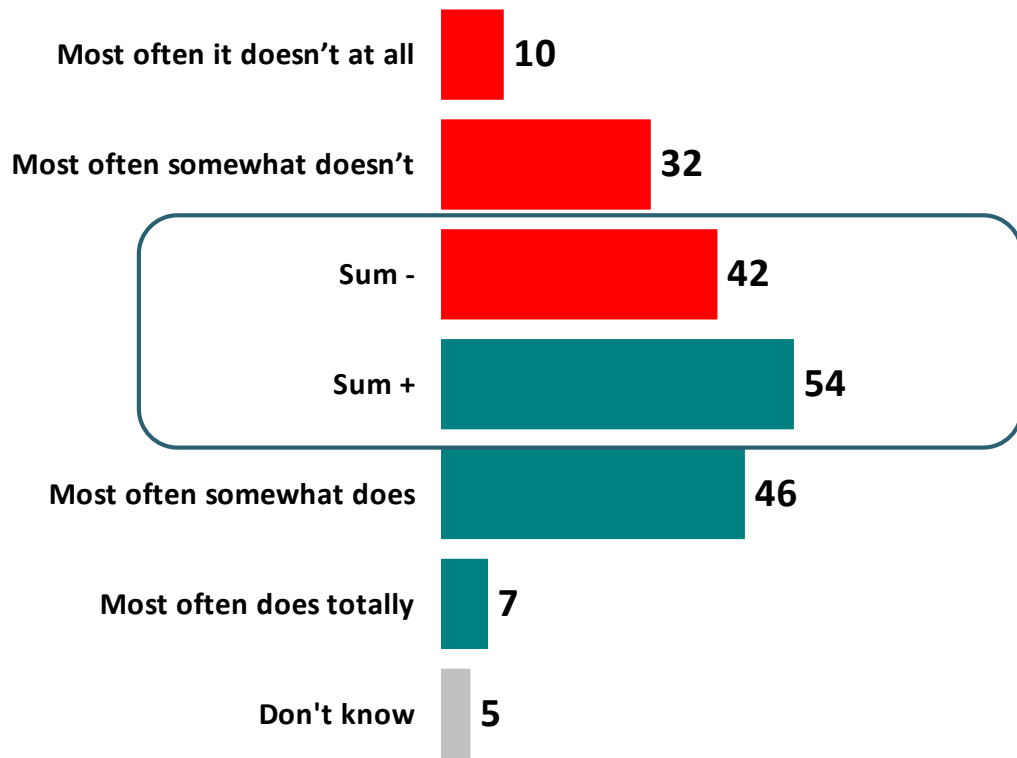

# A majority reading articles does not view headlines as adequately reflecting the information contained

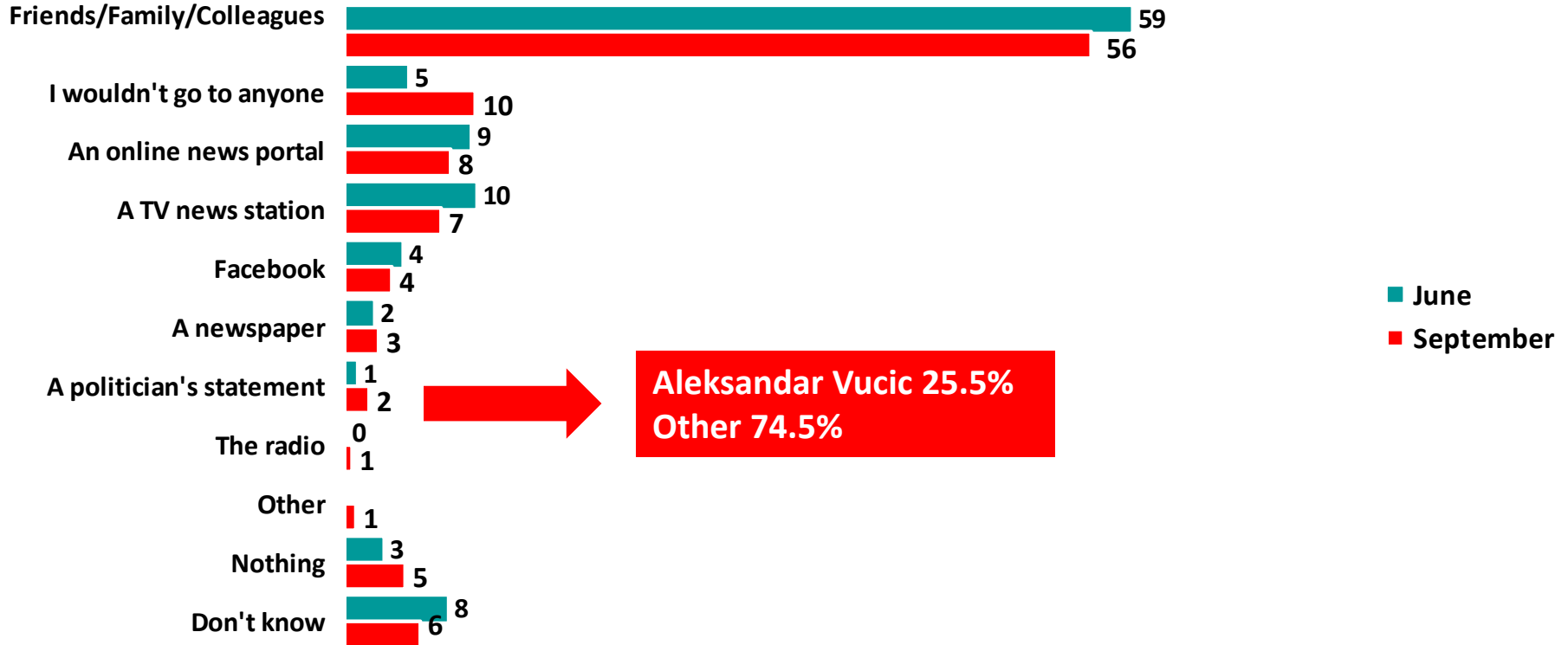
*How much you believe title of the news and accompanying picture reflects the story of the news\**





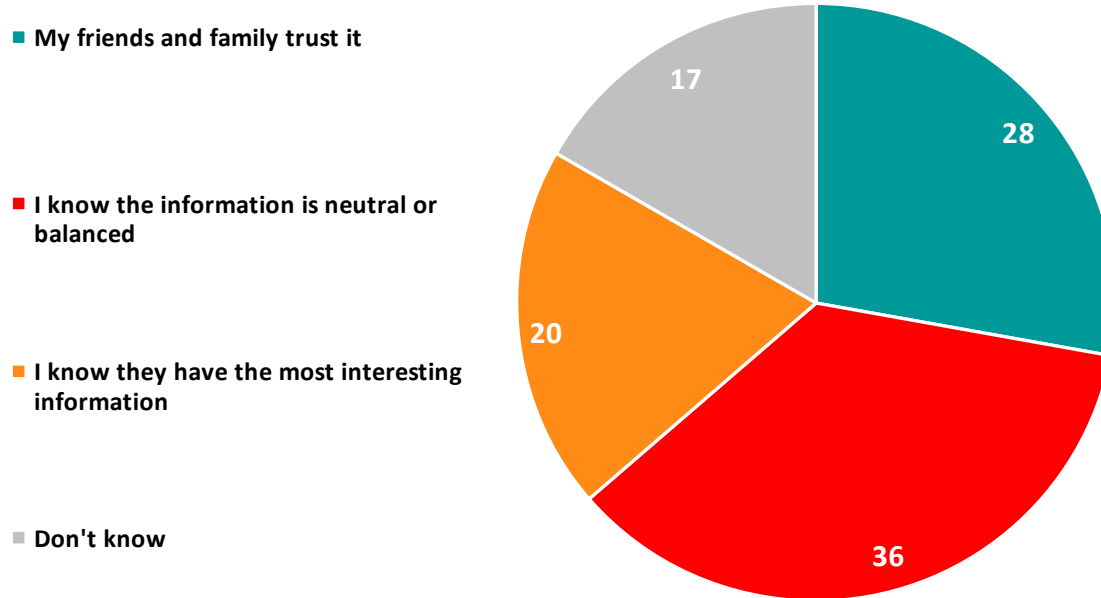
# Citizens look to 'microenvironments' to fact-check information received

If you heard something important to you and/or for you happened, where would you go first to try to find out if it was true?



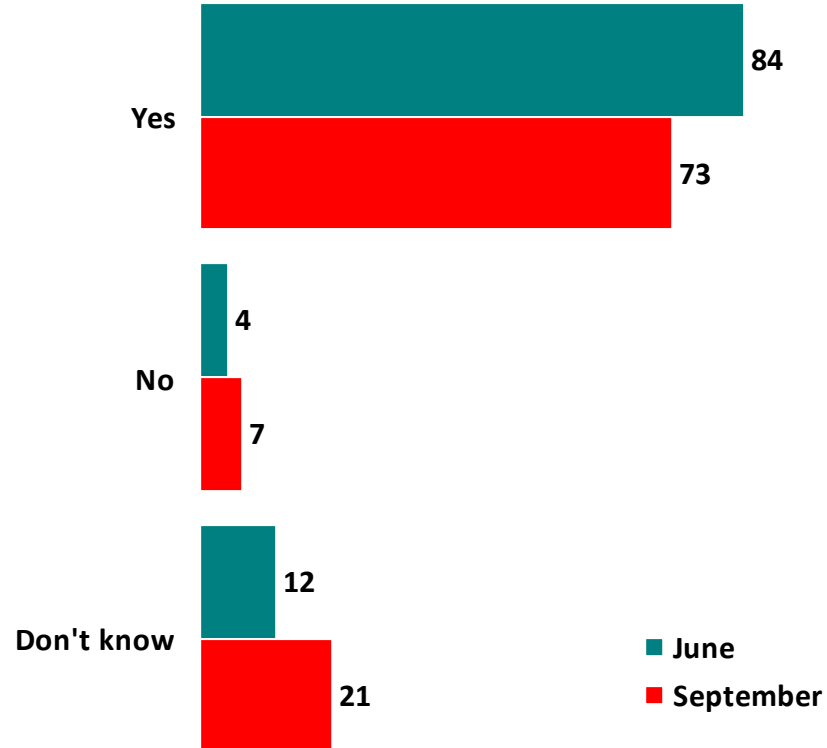
# Neutrality and trust are the most important attributes of a news outlet.

# A high percentage sees 'fake news' present in Serbian media

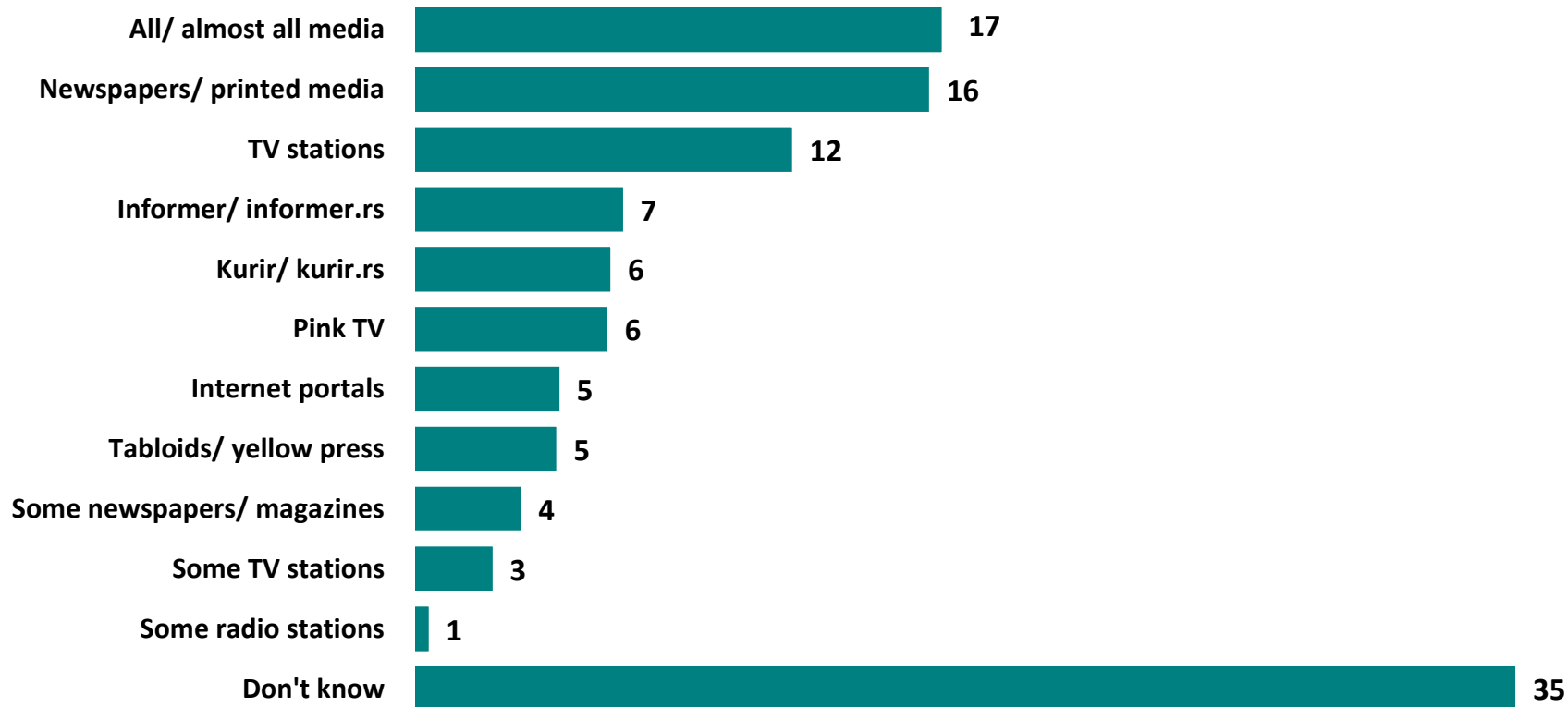
Do you believe there is "fake news" in Serbian media?
